SIDE SWAYS SINGLE, SINGLE, DOUBLE

1 2 3&4

Sway right, left, right (hold/bouncy sway 2 beats)

5 6 7&8

Sway left, right, left for 2

RIGHT FOOT TAPS, STEP POINTS

1 2 3 4

Tap right foot front, out to right side, to the back, and out to right

5 6 7 8

Step forward on right, point left foot out to side, step on left, point right out

ROCKING CHA CHA QUARTER TURNS TO RIGHT, HALF TO LEFT

1 2 3&4

Rock up on right, recover on left making quarter turn right to face 3:00 cha cha in place RLR

5 6 7&8

Rock up on left, recover on right making half turn left to face 9:00, cha cha in place LRL

SINGLE SWAYS, LEAN LEFT Clacking FAN

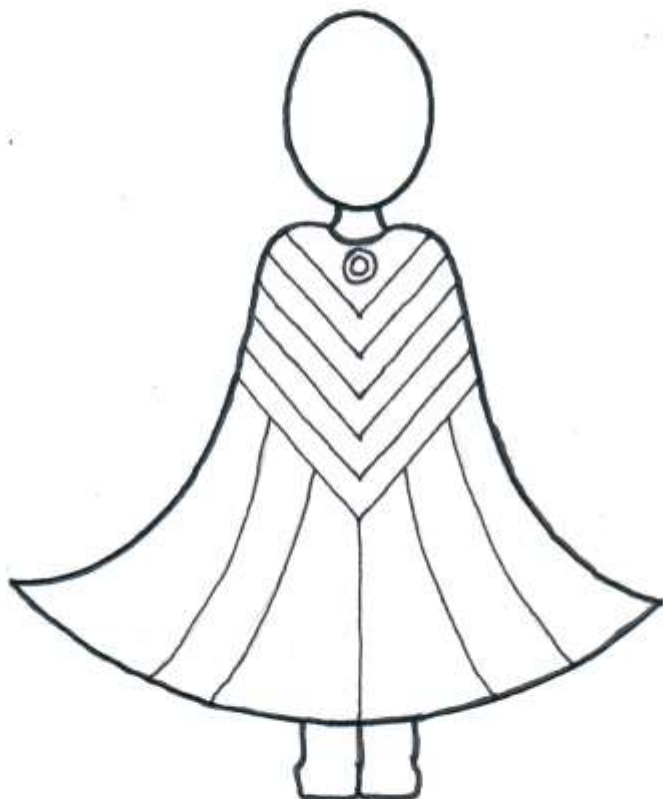
1 2 3 4

Sway right, left, right, left

Lean left bending at waist bouncing to the music and holding fan up and clacking 4 times to the beat
